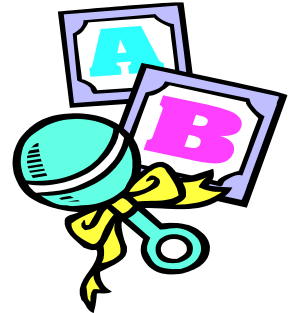

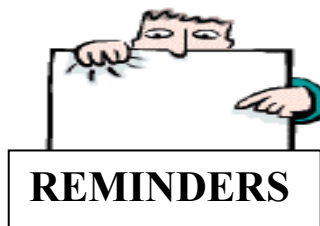

Peabody Veterans Memorial High School Hall of Fame Induction

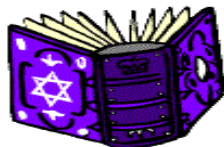
On May 28, 2004, the Peabody Veterans Memorial High School Hall of Fame will induct M. Irving Herbster and Arnold Ordman as members. The Hall of Fame honors those graduates of the High School who have made outstanding contributions to their community and society. M. Irving Herbster was our beloved Ritual Director and Spiritual Leader for many years, and was also involved in numerous Jewish and civic activities, including being the historian of our Jewish Community. He was a lawyer and served as City Solicitor of Peabody during the 1960's, the years of growth of Peabody. His son, Avrom, is our Ritual Committee Chair. Arnold Ordman was appointed by Presidents Kennedy and Johnson to serve as General Counsel of the National Labor Relations Board in Washington D.C., one of the top posts in labor in the Federal Government. Arnold's father, Rev. Maurice Ordman was this Synagogue's first Spiritual Leader. His nephew Paul, is a member of our Board of Directors.

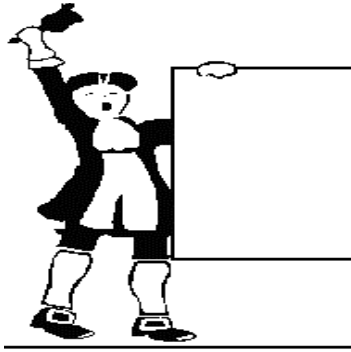
