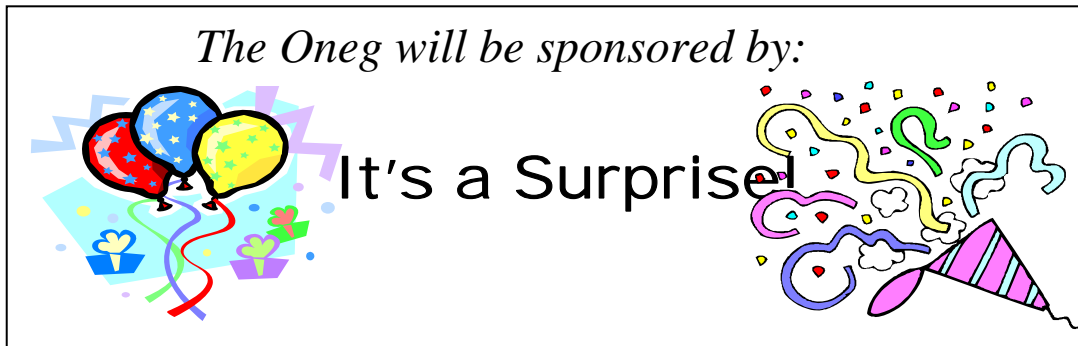

Tzedakah Appeal for North Shore Children's Hospital Special Care Nursery

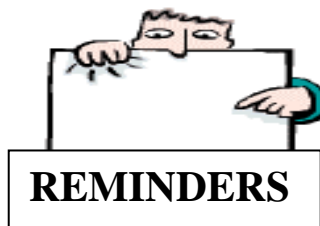

I would like to give newborns a chance for life. I pledge the following to the special Tzedakah Appeal for the North Shore Children's Hospital Special Care Nursery.

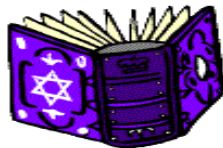

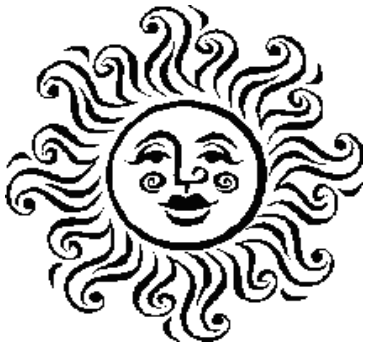
