7th Day - Ma'ariv - Tuesday, April 18th at 7:30 p.m.

7th Day - Shacharis - Wednesday, April 19th at 8:00 a.m. and 8th Day Ma'ariv at 7:30 p.m.

8th Day - Shacharis - Thursday, April 20th at 8:00 a.m. Yizkor will be recited.

If you wish to sell your Chometz in the traditional manner, please call Avrom Herbster at 978-531-4288 by April 5th 2006, as the proper arrangements must be made before Passover. It is customary to give a small amount of money to complete the contract, which will be forwarded to a Rabbi to complete the transaction. Selling your Chometz is a mitzvah, whether or not you keep a Kosher home.

MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

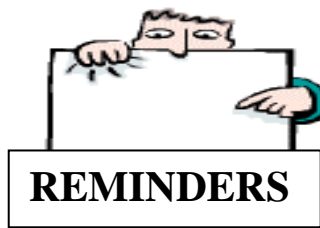
Hi Fellow Congregants,
