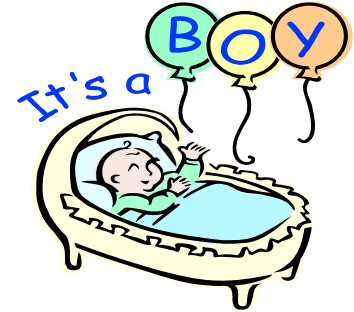

Whitfield holds the Max Richter Chair in American Civilization at Brandeis University and is the author of eight books, including most recently *In Search of American Jewish Culture*, and is the editor, most recently, of *A Companion to 20-Century America*. 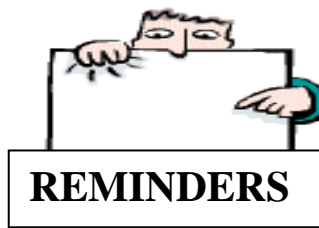

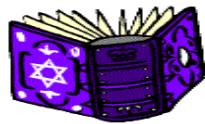

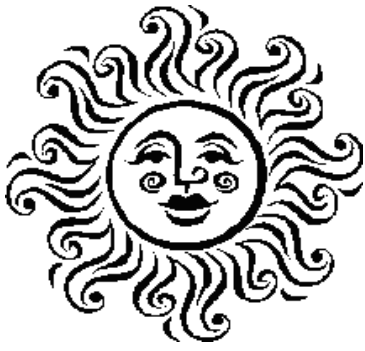
