Simchas Torah

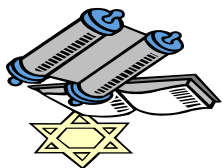

Celebrate the unique and joyous experience of dancing with the Torah.

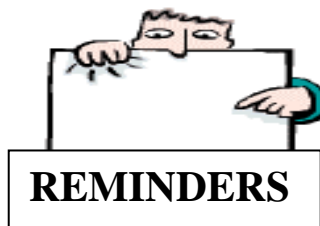
