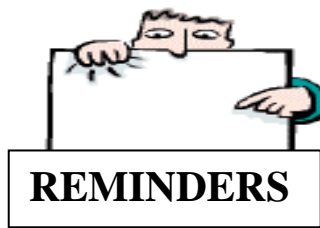

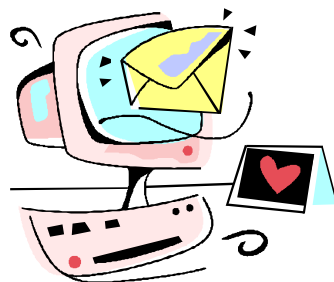

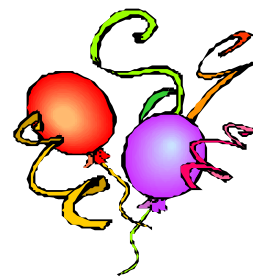

THE SHUL IS GETTING READY FOR OUR 100TH ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION!!



Dear Fellow Congregants,

On May 20, 2007, a steering committee meeting was held for the 100th year celebration of the shul. The purpose of the meeting was to get a sense of the types of events people would be interested in celebrating including the times and places for those events. There was a consensus among the attendees that there will be three events, all being celebrated in the year 2009, 100 years after the shul's incorporation, which was December 14, 1909.

The three events will be as follows: 1) a Friday night service at our shul in May 2009 with a guest Cantor and a Oneg; 2) an evening Gala event in November 2009 complete with keynote speaker, live entertainment and a full course meal; 3) a Proclamation Day on Sunday, December 13, 2009 at the shul with the appropriate dignitaries and with refreshments to follow.

In addition to these events, the shul will be undergoing some renovations under the direction of Building Committee Chairman Steve Greenberg and our Board of Directors, and we will display some of our historical documents and pictures throughout the shul. These events and renovations will require the involvement of all our members.

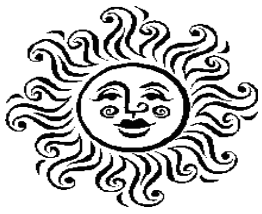
